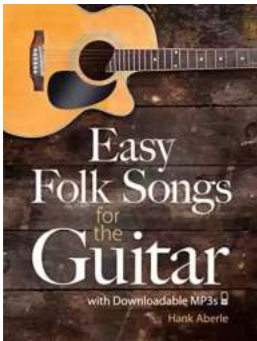

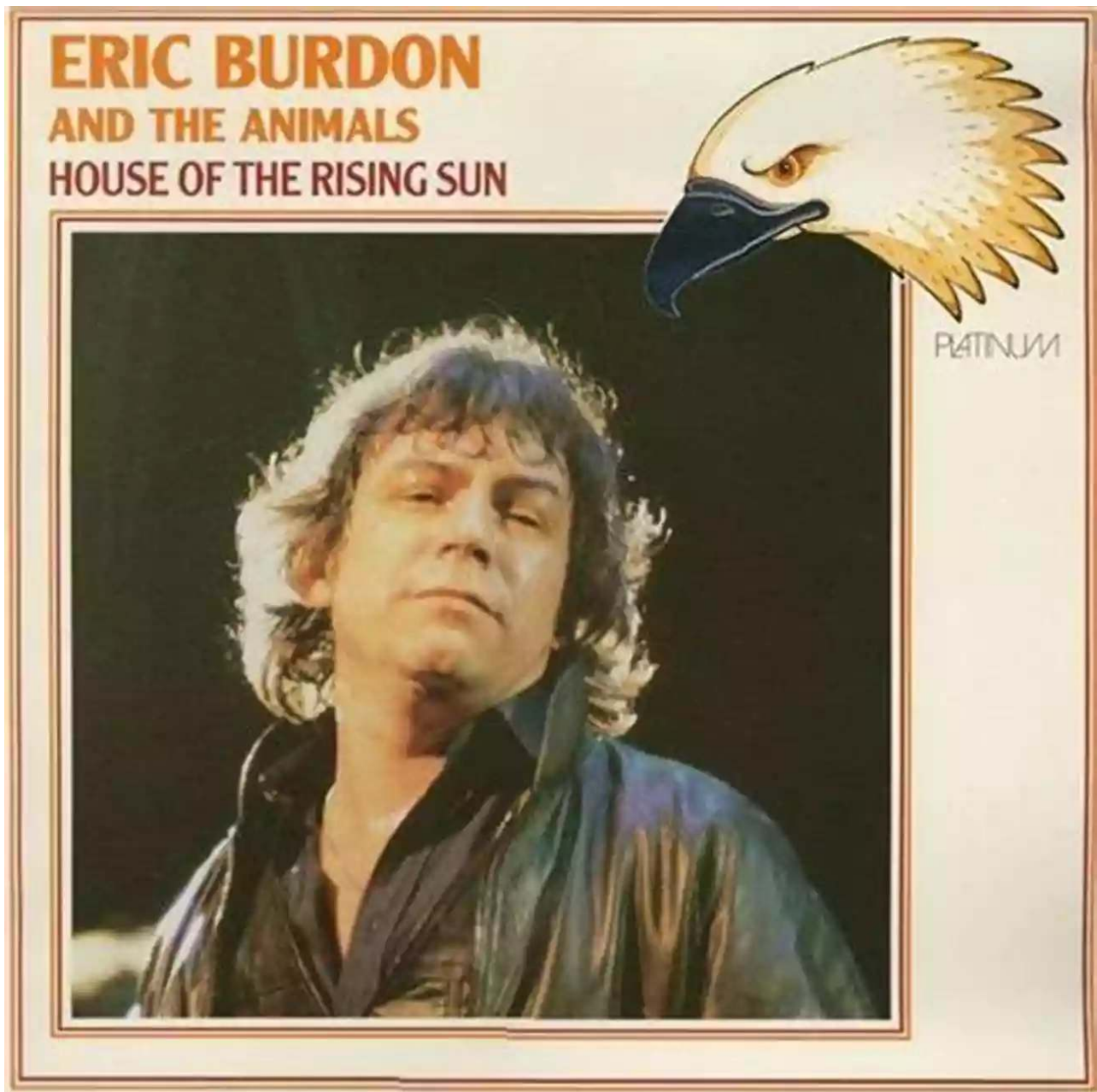


2. "Leaving on a Jet Plane" by John Denver



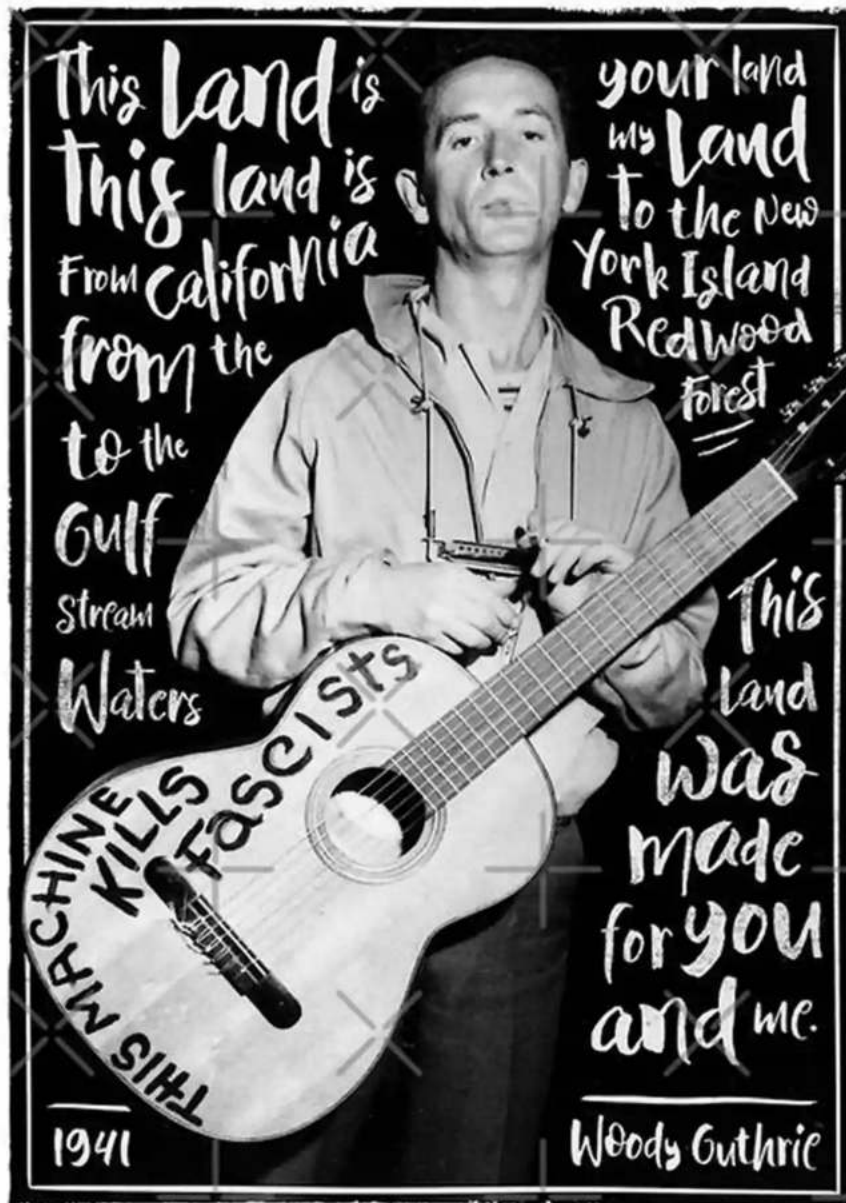

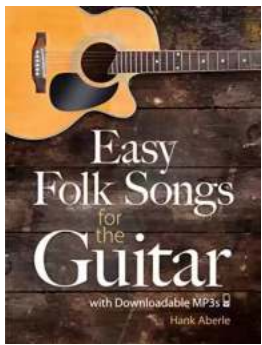
