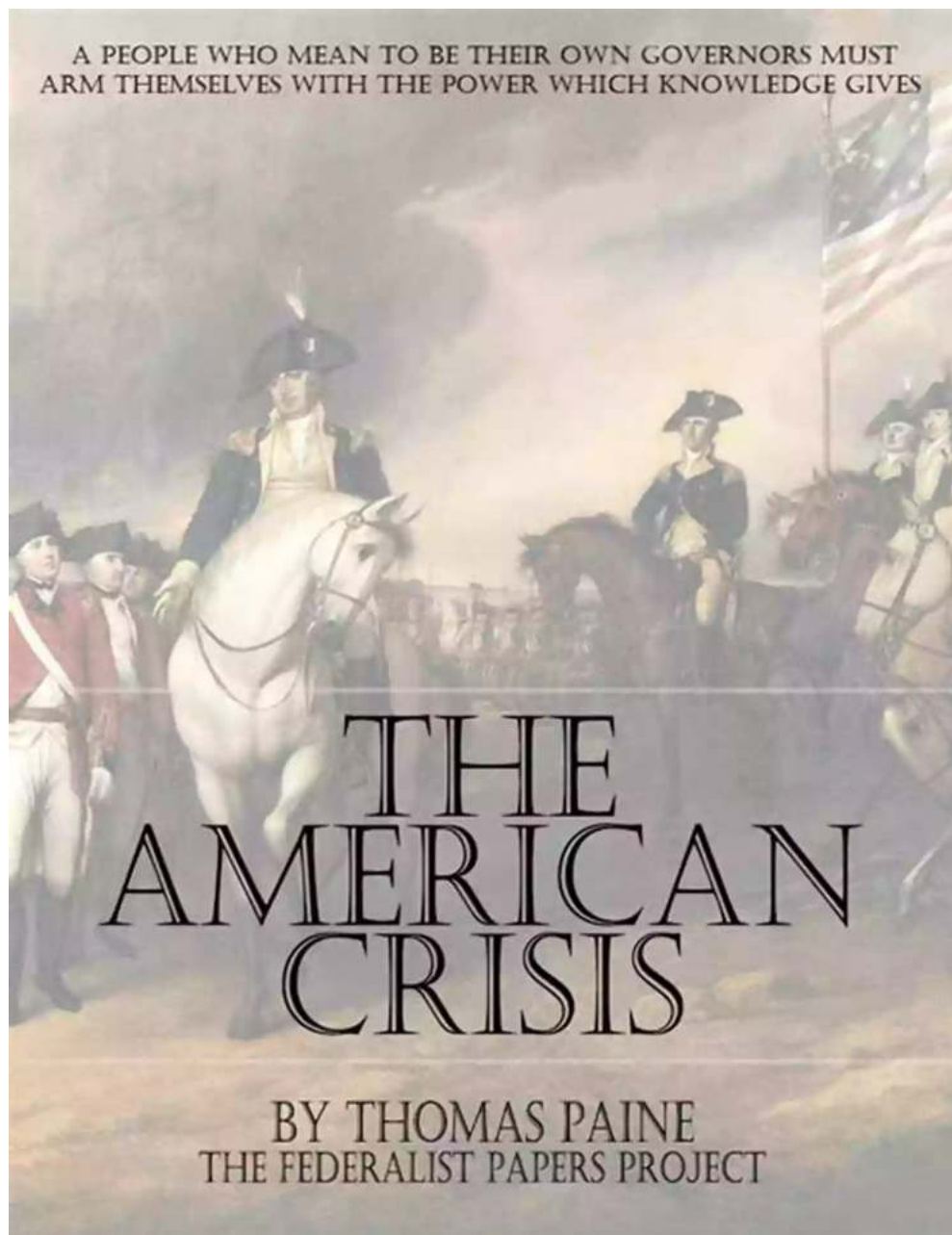
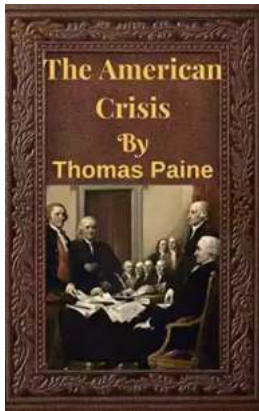

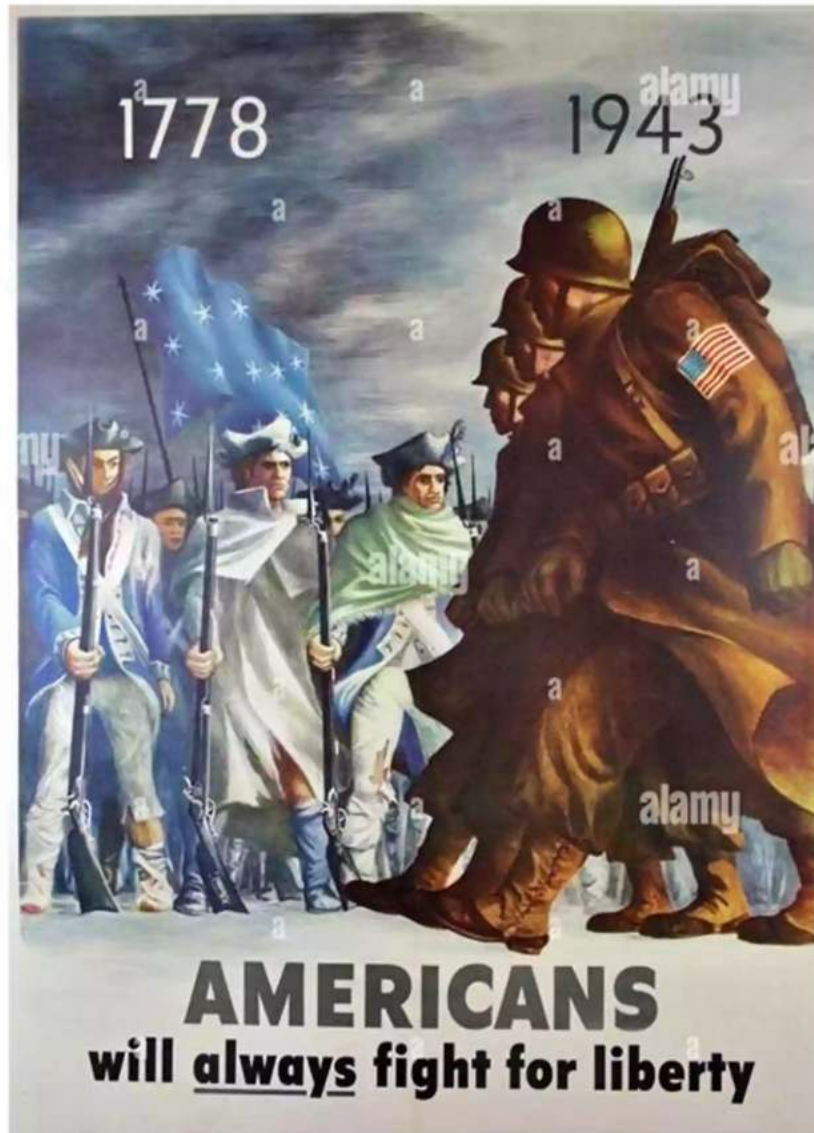


The Composition of *The American Crisis*
