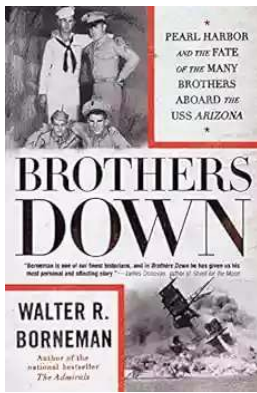


Pearl Harbor And The Fate Of The Many Brothers Aboard The USS Arizona
