






Meet the Ghosts

The new lamps were burned at 145 amperes and 66 arc volts, and the projected picture was an a screen well in excess of 110 feet wide. The theatre is owned and operated by the Carl Floyd circuit. The lamps and rectifiers were installed under supervision of W. V. Toney, National Theatre Supply Co. branch manager in Atlanta, who was enthusiastic over the performance. Toney commented: "When a new piece of equipment performs the way the customers expect it to perform, it must be right and good. It was a fine compliment to the equipment when our customer expressed his delight by immediately sending us his check in full for it."

Another ghostly presence is that of an elderly woman affectionately known as "Frieda." Believed to have been a former theater volunteer, Frieda's apparition has been spotted roaming the balcony. Some claim they can even hear her soft whispers during late-night performances.
