

HMAS Australia was a lucky ship. HMAS Australia had the most colourful service of any Australian Navy ship in Word War II, but that service was ended by the kamikazes. She did not sink, but her war was over.

The story of HMAS Australia brings to an end the trilogy of books on the service of Bobby Forbes. By March 1944, when he left HMAS Australia, he had sailed in all of the world's oceans and fought against all of Australia's foes of World War II.
