

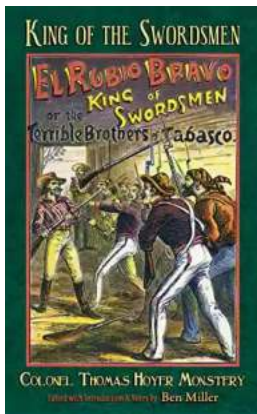

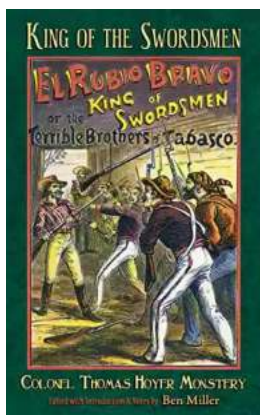

Colonel Thomas Hoyer Monstery was one of the most celebrated swordsmen in American history. Accompanying Monstery on these journeys are his two indefatigable companions: the revolver-toting, pugilistic Englishman, Dr. Charlie Brown, and the honorable but roguish Hispanic cavalier, Don Jose Ramirez. Together, these three seek their fortunes while attempting to rescue the beautiful but fiery Carmelita Ximenes—a character directly based on Monstery’s own wife.
