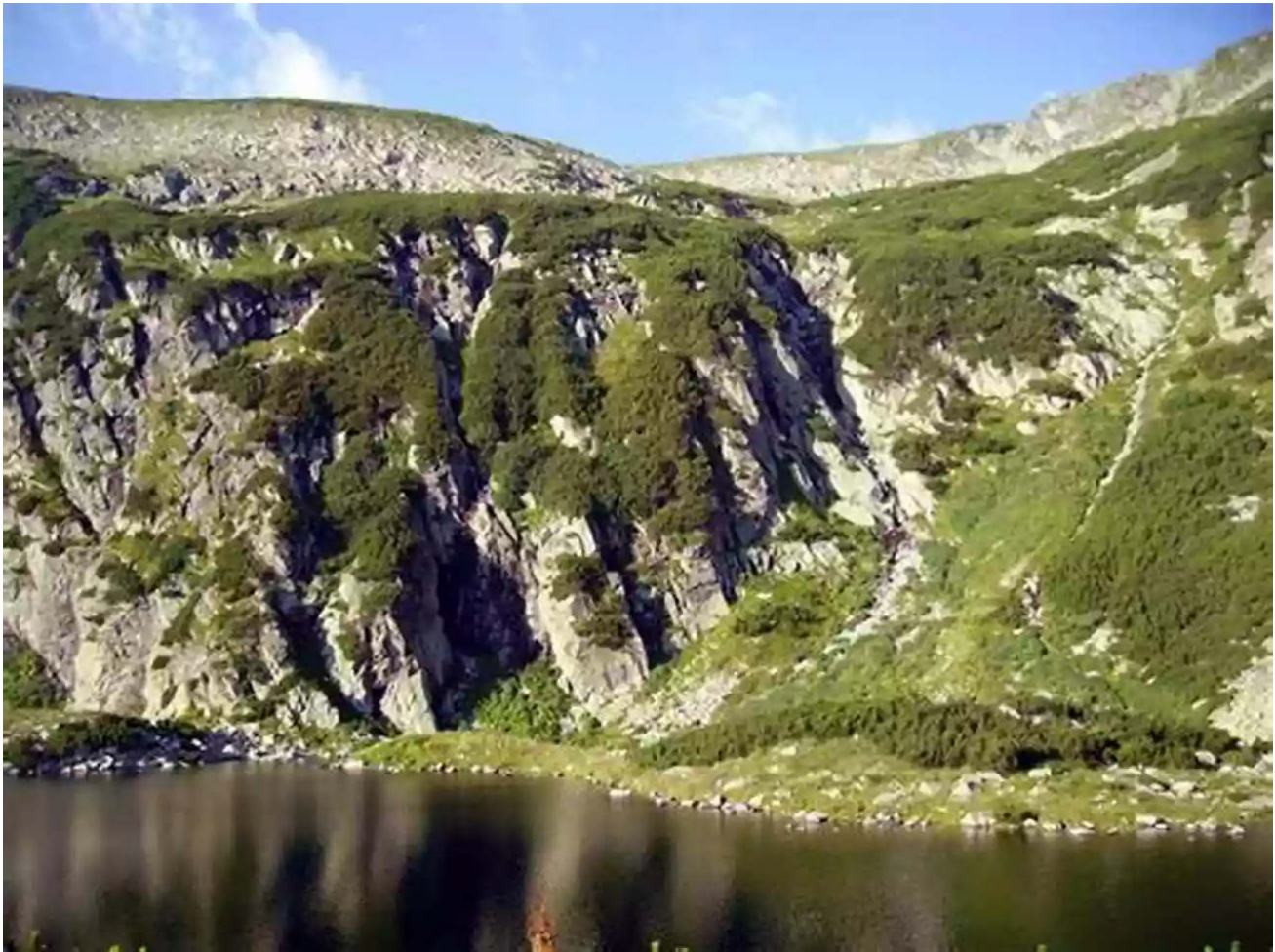

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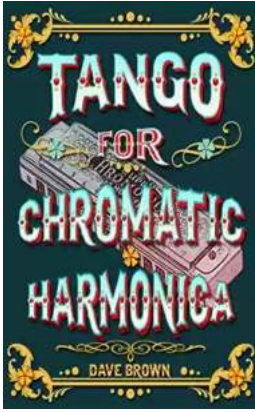

Throughout it all they kept their sense of humour even when their luggage went missing.



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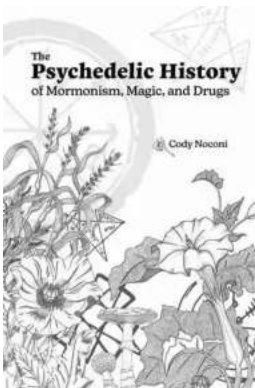
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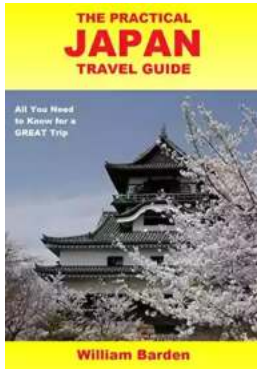
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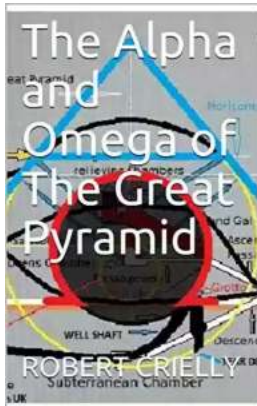
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
