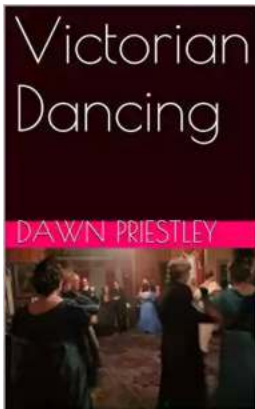

Gradually beat in 6 large free range eggs (beaten), adding a little bit at a time and beating well after each addition. (If the mixture begins to curdle, add a spoonful of the flour.)

Fold in 6 ounces (a scant 1 1/2 cups) of self raising flour, using a large metal spoon with a cutting motion, taking care not to knock too much air out of the cake batter.

Divide the batter equally betwixt 2 (7-inch) buttered and lined cake tins. Level off and make a dip in the centre of each.

Cool baked cakes completely before filling with some jam and butter cream, and dusting with icing sugar.

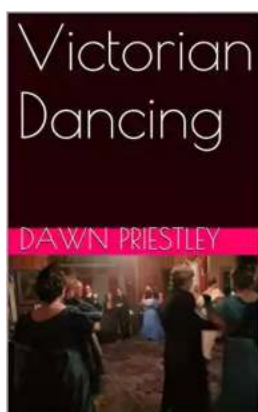

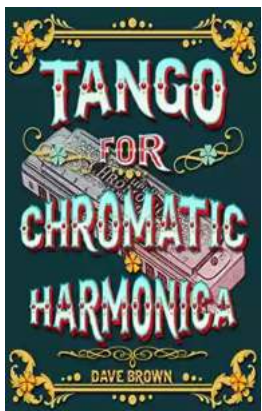

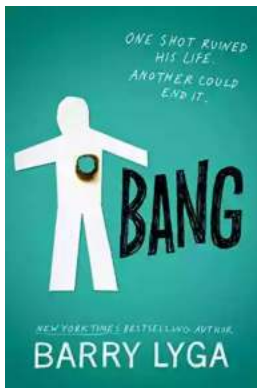
