


1. Strategic Placements in the Backline





In the game of rugby, a place kicker can place the ball on the ground and attempt to placekick it through the posts for 3 points (for a penalty kick), or 2 points (for a convert). He may place the ball anywhere in a straight line (parallel to the sidelines) behind the mark awarded by the referee. My explanation finds the exact place to put your ball to maximize your angle that you are aiming at. I give you a very easy way to estimate closely this exact point by line of sight. I also back up my findings by a mathematical proof using Calculus. A coach or placekicker does not need to know this "proof", but a Calculus teacher or student might find it to be an interesting use of Calculus.
